- 1. You will need to find a minimum of 5 poems that illustrate the poetry terms we've been discussing class.
- 2. You must find 15 different examples of terms/techniques. (You must EXPLAIN why you believe something is paradox, symbol, or irony)
- 3. You need to copy the poem, and mark (hi-lite, underline, etc.) the technique or devise being used in the poem. (be VERY specific...that may mean only underlining letters, words, etc. as necessary)
- 4. Each poem may not have more than 4 terms or techniques marked.
- 5. You may use poetry from any source, as long as it is age appropriate. Also, the poetry must be published...that means you could find it in a BOOK, not just the internet. You may NOT use:

Mother Goose

- 6. The project must be typed and contain a cover page with your name, my name and the hour.
- 7. The project is worth 100 points and will be due on:
